VINIFICATION	fermented and aged in 2,000 litre used oak barrel
ANALYTIC	Alcohol 12,0% vol. Acidity 4,6 g/l Sugar 1,0 g/l Contains sulphites
WINE DESCRIPTION	Bright green-yellow; very compact Muscat fruit with hints of Flintstone in the nose; on the palate, delicate herbal notes, with fine Muscat aromas, with good length.

FOODPAIRING	White meat and light sauces, light fish dishes.
